# REMINDERS. PLEASE BE SURE TO READ YOU LEASE AND COMPLY.

Complaints are already being received regarding operation of golf carts. Lights must be on golf carts after dark. Age of drivers and speed have also been mentioned.

**Golf Carts - No oneunder the age of 15** is allowed to drive a golf cart. It does not matter if an adult is on the cart, a driver must be 15 and if the driver does not have a valid driver's license, then the teenager must be accompanied by an adult.

**Boats - No oneunder the age of 15** is permitted to operate a motor powered boat. Any person age 15 or 16 must be supervised by an adult. The lake is a no wake lake so keep it under 5 mph. Anyone operating a boat on the lake must comply with all Nebraska Boat Safety Rules and Regulations and all Nebraska State Game and Parks Rules and Regulations.

Pets must be on leashes or kenneled at all times.

Speed limit is 10 mph

Quiet time begins at 10 pm Sun – Thu nights and 12 pm Fri/Sat nights.
